The Feast of St. Dominic: St. Dominic is celebrating the feast of St. Dominic **next weekend by reciting the rosary before each Mass.** St. Dominic was born in 1170 in Calaruega, Spain. St. Dominic is most famous for founding the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans). He died from an illness on August 6, 1221 and was canonized a Saint in 1234. Tradition says that the devotion of the Rosary was first revealed to St. Dominic by the Blessed Mother in a vision.
