**I just want to share a brief update about our projects in Kyarusozzi, Uganda. We have almost completed the piggery structure, and when I return to Uganda on September 6, we will buy our first pigs. Because it takes about a year for a piggery to start bringing income, we will use some of the funds to begin training parents and help them kick start their home projects.**

**Also, due to the most recent fundraising opportunities, we now have enough funding to begin and finish the women's dorm at the vocational school. This past month, the school officially changed it's name to St. John Bosco Vocational School.**
