**Child Abuse Prevention** - Few of us would hesitate to educate the children in our lives about the danger of fire and how to escape. Child abuse is a more difficult subject to address. **Learn, Act, Connect, Pray** Abuse is an interpersonal danger. We wish our children could be shielded from the awareness that such evil exists. We want our children to love and trust others and we don't want them to be fearful or anxious. But just as with fire, we risk our children being hurt if we don't provide them a plan for safety. Whenever possible point out concrete aspects of each safety plan within the environment. Children take great comfort in knowing that there is a plan and the mere act of formulating a plan increases the likelihood that they will know what to do to be safe in the face of danger. As you continue through the month of April, focusing your thoughts and prayers on the problem of child abuse, consider how you may be part of the solution
