**St. Dominic is celebrating the feast of St. Dominic this weekend by reciting the rosary before each Mass.** St. Dominic was born in 1170 in Calaruega, Spain. St. Dominic is most famous for founding the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans). He died from an illness on August 6, 1221 and was canonized a Saint in 1234. Tradition says that the devotion of the Rosary was first revealed to St. Dominic by the Blessed Mother in a vision.



**Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion Training.** The diocese requires that Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion be trained, recertified and mandated by the bishop every three years. If your mandate has expired, or is about to expire, you are asked to attend training to renew it in order to continue ministering as an Extraordinary Minister.
