Parish needs financial help from all our parishioners. Currently the Church general fund will be short in making the budget goal at the end of the fiscal year on June 30. We are currently looking at a deficit of \$111,658.00. There are also several building and maintenance issues that need to be addressed this summer or shortly after.

Church General Fund:

- Envelope contributions to meet our budgeted goal of \$635,000 by June 30, 2018
- All Saints Academy and Mater Dei families to be up to date on contributions to their parish

Building Fund:

- Church water sealer/repair exterior \$35,000
- Replacing parish center boiler (installed 1964) with new energy efficient model \$ 25,000
- Replacing three entry doors to the Church \$50,000
- Replacing gym lighting with LED
- Repair and replace interior plaster of Church
- Additional security cameras for the school
