We are currently looking at a deficit of \$63,000.00. There are also several building and maintenance issues that need to be addressed this summer or shortly there after.

Church General Fund:

- Envelope contributions to meet our budgeted goal of \$635,000 by June 30, 2018
- All Saints Academy and Mater Dei families to be up to date on weekly contributions to the parish

Building Fund:

- Church water sealer/repair exterior \$35,000
- Replacing parish center boiler (installed 1964) with new energy efficient model \$ 25,000
- Replacing three entry doors to the Church \$50,000
- Replacing gym lighting with LED
- Repair and replace interior plaster of Church
- Additional security cameras for the school
