Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion Training. The diocese requires that Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion be trained, recertified and mandated by the bishop every three years. If your mandate has expired, or is about to expire, you are asked to attend training to renew it in order to continue ministering as an Extraordinary Minister. St. Dominic will host a training session on August 19th at 7:00pm in Church. St. Francis, Aviston, will host two identical training sessions on Monday, August 20th and Tuesday, August 21st at 7:00pm in Church at Aviston. You may attend any one of these sessions. This training is mandatory for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. New individuals are welcome to attend upon receiving their pastor's approval.

Parish needs financial help from all our parishioners. Currently the Church general fund was short in making the budget goal at the end of the fiscal year on June 30. There are also several building and maintenance problems being addressed this summer or shortly thereafter.

Building Fund:

- Church water sealer/repair to exterior has begun. Please be careful and aware of the workers and equipment.
- Replacing the parish center boiler (installed 1964) with new energy efficient model. The old boiler is removed and waiting for the new boiler to be installed.
- Replacing three entry doors to the Church will begin September 24th.
- Replacing gym lighting with LED has been approved by IMEA.
- Repair and replace interior plaster of Church once outside waterproofing and doors are completed.
- Additional security cameras for the school are being discussed.
