**529 Plans for Catholic K-12 Schools** The Act adds new section 529(c)(7) to permit qualified tuition plans to make nontaxable distributions for tuition in connection with attendance or enrollment at an elementary or secondary public, private, or religious school, up to \$10,000 incurred during each tax year, on a per-student basis. This provision does not expire after 2025.
