- 2). Christmas Decorations shall be removed by March 1st.
- 3). Easter Decorations shall be removed by May 1st.
- 4). Memorial Day Decorations shall be removed by June 15th.
- 5). All Decorations remaining after the posted dates will be removed by the maintenance crew.
- 6). Spent flowers will be removed after burial or special occasion.
