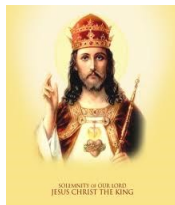
New Doors You should have received a letter about the new doors for Church. If you would like to make a donation towards the doors, please return your donation in the yellow envelope to the church office. Thank you.
