**Youth Faith Formation Confirmation class will be collecting for Heifer International** at all masses on April 6 and 7. Heifer International is a non-profit organization that sends animals to provide a sustainable income to poverty stricken communities throughout the world. The class has raised over \$7000 in the past six years and their goal this year is to raise \$1400 to provide animals to nine countries; including \$200 to be sent directly to Katie Robben's mission in Uganda for her piggyery. Your continued support of this project is appreciated.

**Snack Pack Program of Clinton County** There are 1,470 children in Clinton County that are food insecure. That is 1 in 6 children that don't always have enough food to eat. This program started in December 2014 providing food to 17 kids each weekend in one school district. Five years later the program has grown and is currently providing food to 256 children in 13 different Clinton county school districts. Each weekend snack pack bag contains enough food for breakfast and lunch for Saturday and Sunday. Principals decide which kids are in need of extra food. Each week bags are dropped off by volunteers and given to the students on Friday to take home over the weekend. This is a way for us to get the food directly into the children's hands to help bridge the food gap over the weekend. Food that the kids will eat and can prepare themselves. It cost \$15 per month or \$135 to sponsor one child for the school year. All donations go directly to purchasing food. **This Tuesday, March 26th at 6:00pm, we are asking for volunteers (adults & students) to help pack food at the First United Methodist Church in Trenton. This would be great for any student who needs service hours.**

**Respect Life Corner: Unplanned:** A new movie about abortion is being released by Pure Flix. Unplanned is the inspiring true story of one woman's journey of transformation. "All Abby Johnson ever wanted to do was help women. As one of the youngest Planned Parenthood clinic directors in the nation, she was involved in upwards of 22,000 abortions and counseled countless women about their reproductive choices. Her passion surrounding a woman's right to choose even led her to become a spokesperson for Planned Parenthood, fighting to enact legislation for the cause she so deeply believed in. Until the day she saw something that changed everything, leading Abby Johnson to join her former enemies at 40 Days For Life, and become one of the most ardent pro-life speakers in America." While the film does carry a "R" rating, the story that it tells is too great to be avoided. Unplanned opens in local theaters this Thursday, March 28<sup>th</sup>.
