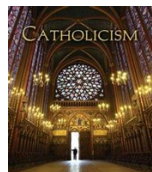

Lent & Lenten Regulations: Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 26. This is a day of fasting. Everyone 14 years of age or over and in good health is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. The other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but altogether they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the obligation of the law is modified. Because Lent is a special season for all Christians, we should not lightly excuse ourselves from these penitential practices.

Lenten Adoration begins on Thursday, February 27, 2020. St. Dominic will again offer weekly adoration on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays during Lent from 1 to 7 pm. Sign up sheets are located in the back of church. Please call Allison at 526-7153 if you have any questions.

Lent is our season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. The use of ashes for all the faithful at the start of Lent began in the tenth century. In many ways it is ironic that on the day we hear Jesus speak of praying, fasting, and almsgiving being done in secret, we participate in what may be the year's most public physical statement of our belief in him! As we are signed on the forehead with the Cross (a gesture that, with holy oil, is also part of Baptism, Confirmation, and Anointing) we are told to "Repent and believe in the Gospel." Alternatively, the formula "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return" is used, which also points to the urgency of recognizing and reconciling our sinfulness. We are reminded that with our Baptism has come the responsibility to live our lives for the Lord
