St. Dominic is celebrating the feast of St. Dominic this weekend by reciting the rosary before each Mass. St. Dominic was born in 1170 in Calaruega, Spain. St. Dominic is most famous for founding the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans). He died from an illness on August 6, 1221 and was canonized a Saint in 1234. Tradition says that the devotion of the Rosary was first revealed to St. Dominic by the Blessed Mother in a vision.



Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion Training. The diocese requires that Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion be trained, recertified and mandated by the bishop every three years. If your mandate has expired, or is about to expire, you are asked to attend training to renew it in order to continue ministering as an Extraordinary Minister. St. Dominic will host a training session on August 19th at 7:00pm. St. Francis, Aviston, will host two identical training sessions on Monday, August 20th and Tuesday, August 21st at 7:00pm at St. Francis in Aviston. You may attend any one of these sessions. This training is mandatory for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. New individuals are welcome to attend upon receiving their pastor's approval.

Building Fund:

- Church water sealer/repair to exterior has begun. Please be careful and aware of the workers and equipment.
- Replacing the parish center boiler (installed 1964) with new energy efficient model. The old boiler is removed and waiting for the new boiler to be installed.
- Replacing three entry doors to the Church will begin September 24th.
- Replacing gym lighting with LED has been approved by IMEA.
- Repair and replace interior plaster of Church once outside waterproofing and doors are completed.
- Additional security cameras for the school are being discussed.
