Respect Life Corner:

Love is Our Life Mission – “The spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me; he has sent me to bring comfort to the poor, to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captive. "God's love is our life mission. If we choose to embrace this mission, we will have a new perspective on many issues. This may also mean that we will sometimes live as minorities, with different values from our surrounding secular culture. **Learn, Act, Connect, Pray:** If we understand that love is our mission then we have learned a basic truth that will shape many other areas of life. Pray for the ability to see clearly the path to take when situations arise that are contrary to our beliefs as Catholics.

Take Five For Faith:

Love is Bigger Than Hurt—Joseph had it tough as the second youngest in a family of 12 brothers. Picked on and hated because he was his dad Jacob’s favorite, Joseph ended up sold into slavery by his brothers. After many years of separation from his family, he again meets his brothers, only this time the tables are turned: Joseph is in a position of power, and his brothers are the vulnerable ones. It wouldn’t have taken much for Joseph to tap back into those feelings of hurt, betrayal, and rage and respond measure for measure. But he went beyond that, back to the sibling love he so cherished, and reacted with not only kindness but an outpouring of generosity. We, too, have that capacity and power for a love that is bigger than hurt.

Did you know...St. Dominic offers a Roses for Life program, in which you call the rectory to put an unborn baby and mother on our prayer list and have a rose placed on Mary’s Altar in their honor. Once God’s greatest gift arrives, the rose can be removed and taken home.



Parish needs financial help from all our parishioners. Currently the Church general fund was short in making the budget goal at the end of the fiscal year on June 30. There are also several building and maintenance problems being addressed this summer or shortly there after.

Building Fund:

- Church water sealer/repair to exterior has begun. Please be careful and aware of the workers and equipment.
- Replacing the parish center boiler (installed 1964) with new energy efficient model. The old boiler is removed and waiting for the new boiler to be installed.
- Replacing three entry doors to the Church will begin September 24th.
- Replacing gym lighting with LED has been approved by IMEA.
- Repair and replace interior plaster of Church once outside waterproofing and doors are completed.
- Additional security cameras for the school are being discussed.
