Building Fund:

- Church water sealer/repair to exterior is almost finished. Please be careful and aware of the workers and equipment.
- Replacing the parish center boiler (installed 1964) with new energy efficient model. The old boiler is removed and waiting for the new boiler to be installed.
- Replacing three entry doors to the Church will begin September 24th.
- Replacing gym lighting with LED has been approved by IMEA and will be completed with the next few weeks.
- Repair and replace interior plaster of Church once outside waterproofing and doors are completed.
- Additional security cameras for the school are being discussed.
