Respect Life Corner: Holy Week Is Here - If your Lenten journey has been difficult, remember that it's meant to be that way. Giving of ourselves in the midst of our suffering and self-denial brings us closer to loving like Christ, who suffered and poured himself out unconditionally on the Cross for all of us. **Learn, Act, Connect, Pray:** Lent officially ends as the Mass of the Lord's Supper begins. Plan to participate in the moving liturgies of the Triduum in your parish. The summit of the liturgical year, the Easter Triduum begins Holy Thursday and continues into the evening of Easter Sunday. While chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

Rice Bowl - *Encounter Our Neighbors.* We encounter Jesus this week in Jerusalem, a community he knew well. We prayerfully enter our own communities too, encountering those who are hungry and thirsty, and those who need our help.
