**Respect Life Corner- In Psalm 63, David wrote of his thirst for God when he was in the wilderness of Judah. "O God, you are my God, for whom I have been searching earnestly. My soul yearns for you and my body thirsts for you."** This psalm is a beautiful psalm about the longing we experience for Our Lord. It helps us to rediscover in our daily lives, how God is at the center of everything that brings us joy. All good things come from God! His love is the only thing that makes life worth living. Consider the prodigal son (Luke 15) and all that distracted him from his spiritual life. This psalm vocalizes the distress, penitence and ultimately hope of the repentant sinner (us). **Learn, Act, Connect and Pray**-God's mercy and kindness can weave throughout our day through our prayer and people we interact with, if we look for it. To align your thoughts and prayers with God, consider saying "The Our Father" prayer very slowly; praying and reflecting on each word. Surround yourself with sacramental, such as Holy water. Realize now that the evil one knows no boundaries. The righteous are often defenseless before the cynicism and calumnies to which they are prey. God knows all and is all. His judgment overtakes those who believe their actions are hidden from view. In the end, goodness/God wins! Each life will be brought before the judgment of God; the righteous will find their joy in the Lord.

**An Act of Spiritual Communion** It has long been a Catholic understanding that when circumstances prevent one from receiving Holy Communion, it is possible to make an Act of Spiritual Communion which is a source of grace. Spiritual Communion means uniting ourselves in prayer with Christ's sacrifice and worshipping Him in the consecrated bread and wine which are His Body and Blood. Always remember that the consecrated bread is the Body and Blood of Christ and the consecrated wine is the Body and Blood of Christ, even if you receive the Eucharist only under one species. The most common reason for making an Act of Spiritual Communion is when a person cannot attend Mass. An act of Spiritual Communion increases our desire to receive sacramental Communion and helps us avoid the sins that would make us unable to receive Holy Communion worthily.

**A Prayer for Spiritual Communion** My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You in my body, my soul, and my whole being. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, Come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if you were already there And unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You.
