**A Same and Different Ash Wednesday in 2021.** We have had a year filled with different ways of living and praying. There are fewer people in church. No water in the font. Less singing. Communion only in the hand. No coffee and doughnuts on the way home. Yet we still pray. Instead of giving ashes as a cross on the forehead – unsafe in this COVID time – we can still receive them by sprinkling on the top of the head or use a Q-Tip to administer. We can still, however, repent, and believe in the Gospel. We will still bear the ashes home to begin our Lenten practices. Pat has chosen to use Q-tips to put the sign of the cross in ashes on your forehead).**

**Respect Life Corner**—In the Gospel of Mark 1:29-39, "Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed." Simon and the other disciples began looking for Jesus early in the morning after a night of healing in Capernaum. They told him that everyone was looking for him. Jesus immediately says that they will go to the nearby villages to preach and to heal. That very morning, Jesus began his mission to bring spiritual salvation and blessings on all people. For the next three years, Jesus went from town to town preaching the kingdom of God. **Learn, Act, Connect and Pray**—Today we have many advantages over the people of Capernaum. We know that Jesus really is Our Lord and Savior. We know how the Lord came to change lives and how He comes today to change our lives. So today, let's ask ourselves if we are living as Christ calls us to live. Do we equate holiness with happiness? We can discover the peace and joy of living in faith when we explore the beauty of the Catholic faith and how to apply faith to our daily life.

**Act of Spiritual Communion** It has long been a Catholic understanding that when circumstances prevent one from receiving Holy Communion, it is possible to make an Act of Spiritual Communion which is a source of grace. Spiritual Communion means uniting ourselves in prayer with Christ's sacrifice and worshipping Him in the consecrated bread and wine which are His Body and Blood. Always remember that the consecrated bread is the Body and Blood of Christ and the consecrated wine is the Body and Blood of Christ, even if you receive the Eucharist only under one species. The most common reason for making an Act of Spiritual Communion is when a person cannot attend Mass. An act of Spiritual Communion increases our desire to receive sacramental Communion and helps us avoid the sins that would make us unable to receive Holy Communion worthily.

**A Prayer for Spiritual Communion** My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You in my body, my soul, and my whole being. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, Come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You.
