Jesus' promise to his disciples of the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit, is part of the long "Farewell Discourse" near the end of John's Gospel. Jesus made this farewell to his disciples at their Last Supper, just prior to his arrest, crucifixion, death, and Resurrection. This long discourse is a unique summary of the mystery of the Incarnation and the role of the Holy Spirit.

God's promise of the Holy Spirit should not have been a mystery to the followers of Jesus who knew the Holy Scriptures. The origin of this promise can be traced to the Old Testament books of Jeremiah and Ezekiel. In the days of the prophets, God had promised to make a new Covenant with His people. He had promised to put His law within His people, writing it on their hearts, that He might be their God and they might be His people. He had also promised to put a new spirit within His people, to remove their heart of stone and to give them a heart of flesh. And finally, God had promised to put His Spirit within His people to enable them to follow His statutes and be careful to observe His ordinances.

Paul tells us that this promise has been fulfilled: "Do you not know that you are God's Temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?" [1 Cor 3:16].

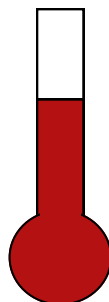
## FAIR TRADE SALE
